At Iver, we highly value your privacy and the protection of your personal data. In this privacy statement, we explain which data we collect, why we collect it, and how we handle it.

1. Collection and Use of Personal Data

We process personal data only for legitimate purposes, such as:

- 🌱 Providing our services in the maintenance, assembly, and disassembly of wind turbines;
- 🌱 Responding to questions and requests via our website or other communication channels;
- 🌱 Improving our website and services based on usage statistics;
- 🌱 Complying with legal obligations.

The personal data we may process includes:

- 🌱 Name, email address, phone number, and company details from contact inquiries;
- 🌱 IP address and website usage data via analytical tools;
- 🌱 Other data that you voluntarily share with us.

2. Data Retention

We do not retain personal data longer than necessary for the purposes for which it was collected unless a longer retention period is legally required.

3. Sharing Data with Third Parties

Iver does not sell your data to third parties. We only share personal data if necessary for the execution of our services or to comply with legal obligations. With parties that process data on our behalf, we enter into data processing agreements to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality.

4. Data Security

We take appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access.

5. Your Rights

You have the right to:

- 🌱 Access your personal data;
- 🌱 Request correction or deletion of your data;
- 🌱 Request restriction of processing or transfer of your data;
- 🌱 Object to data processing;
- 🌱 File a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
